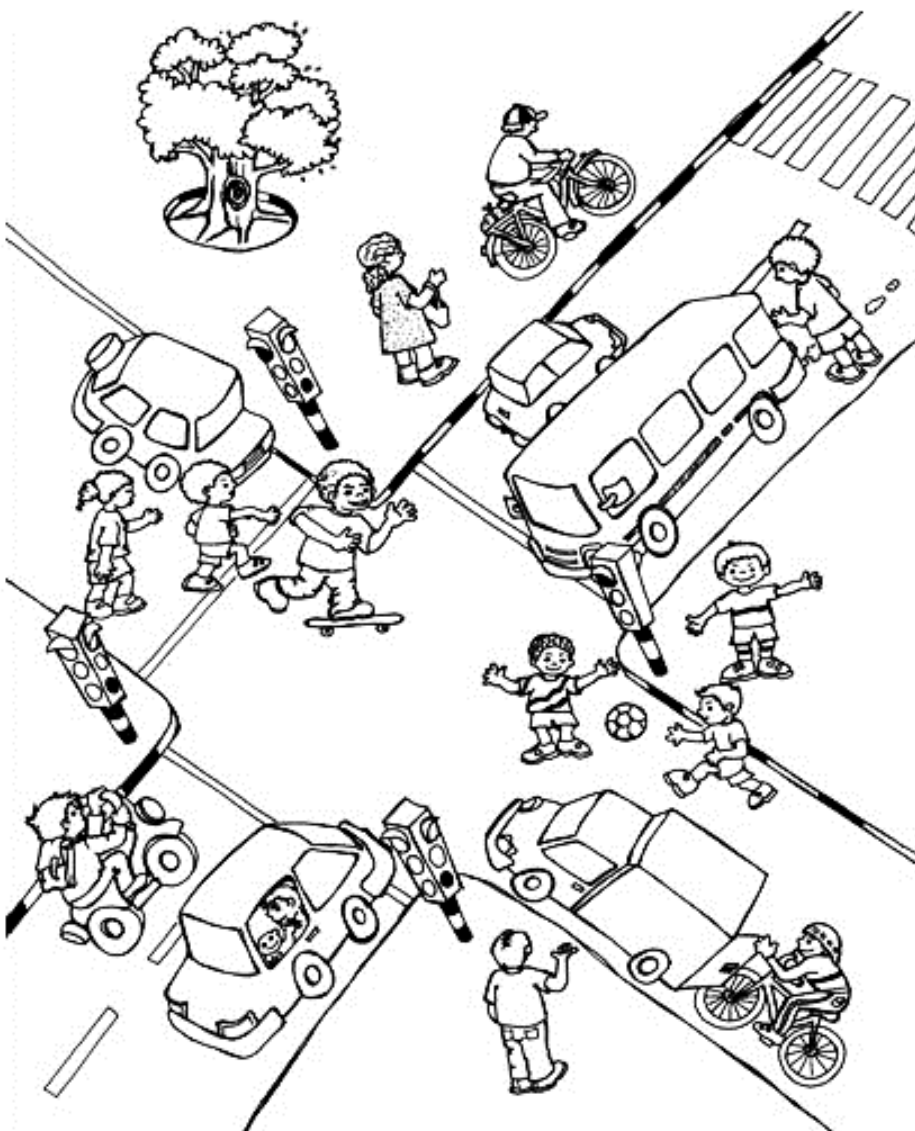

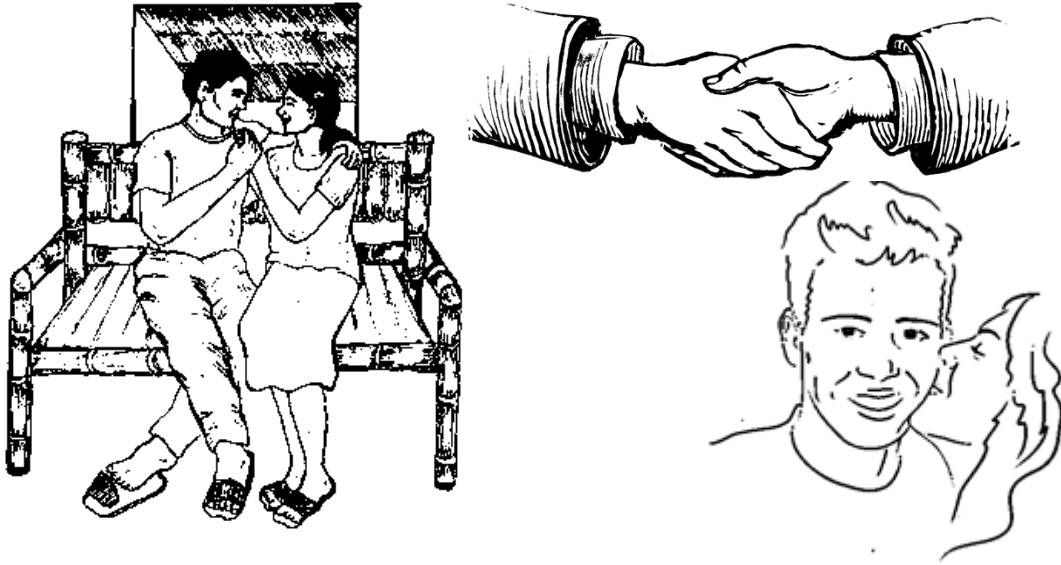
- a) HIV - **Human immunodeficiency virus**

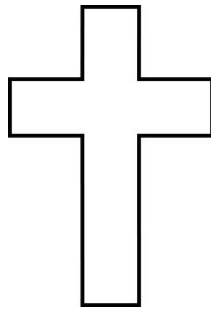
