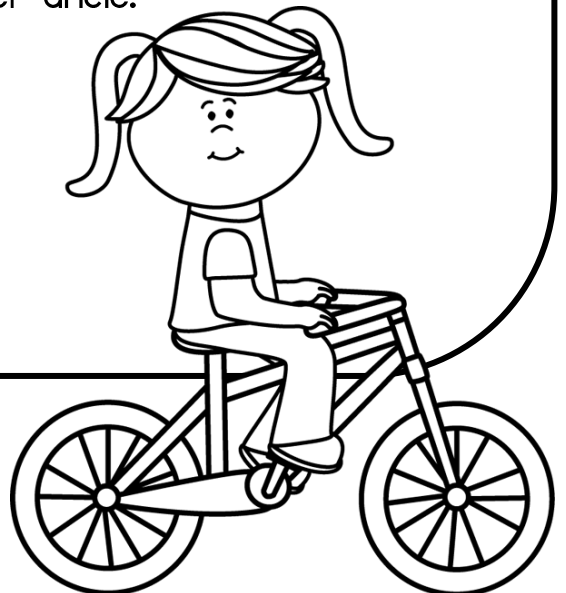
The new bicycle

Ken's room was a mess! There were shoes and toy trucks on the floor. There were books by the door. There were pants on the bed.

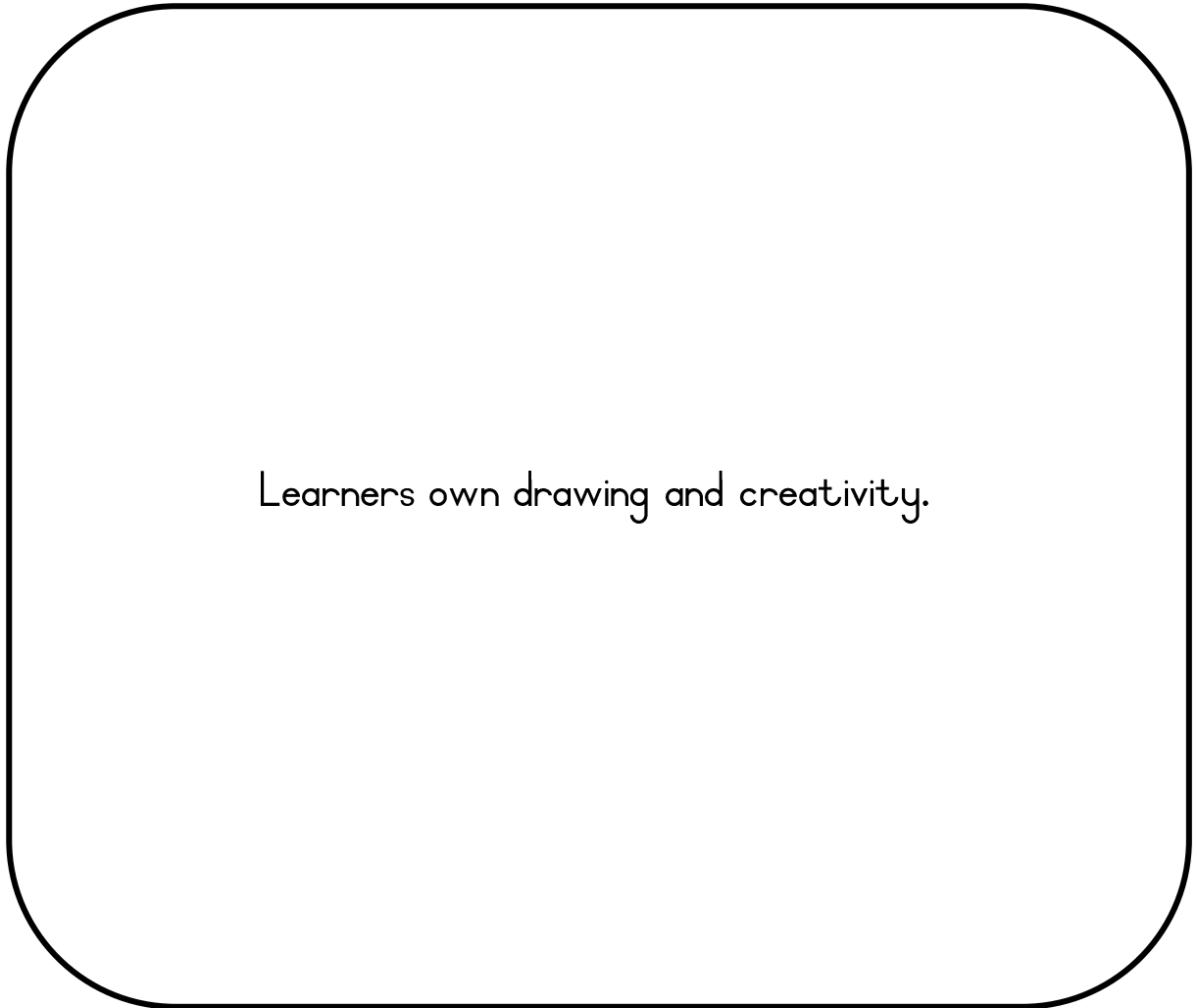
Ken's dad said, "This room is a pig pen!
