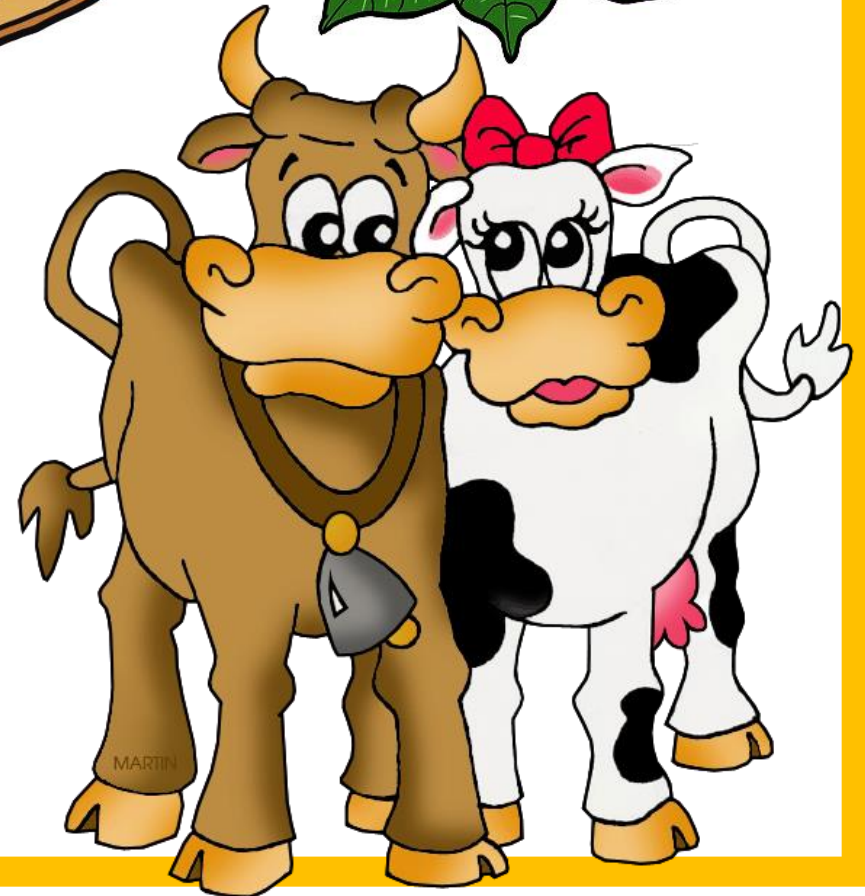
The workshops had a furnace at the farm where labourers made and repaired tools and implements. They also made iron horseshoes and wagon wheels.



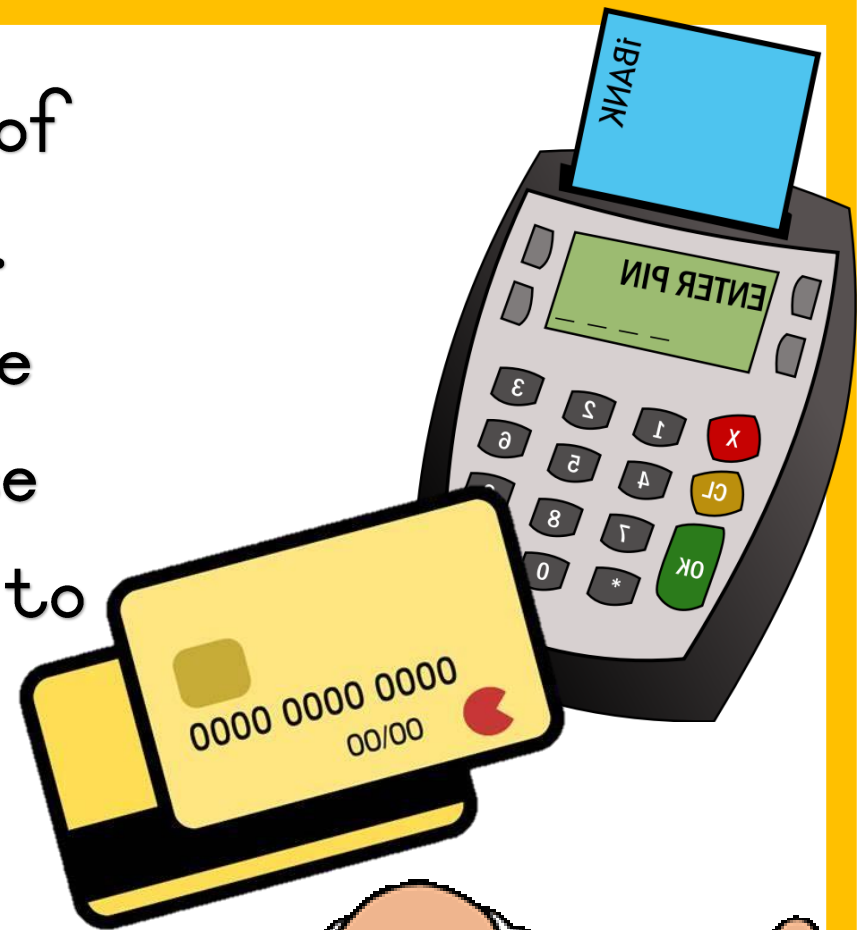
Long ago people did not use coins and notes to pay for things. In these days they used **BARTERING** (a way of exchanging goods.)

They exchanged the following:

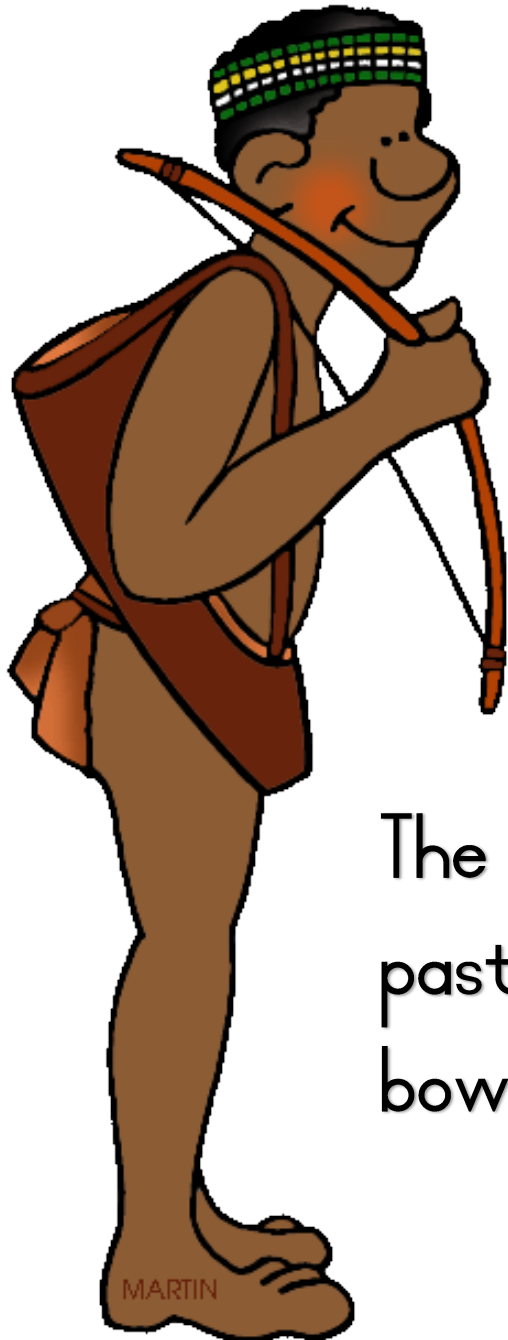
1. Beads
