



Nocturnal animals



Nocturnal animals are animals who sleep during the day and are awake at night.

What do they do at night?

1. Find food.
2. Protect their offspring.
3. Observe their surroundings.



Bats come out at night to catch insects. Bats can "see" at night by making echoes which bounces back from objects.

owls

Owls sleep during the day and come out at night to hunt. Owls see very well in moonlight. They cannot see when it is completely dark.



porcupine

At night they look for food.

They use their strong claws to dig up roots and bulbs to eat.

A firefly glows at night.
The male fireflies glow
to attract females.
