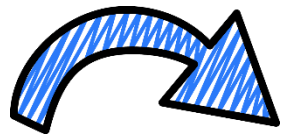


# Noun



(naming word)

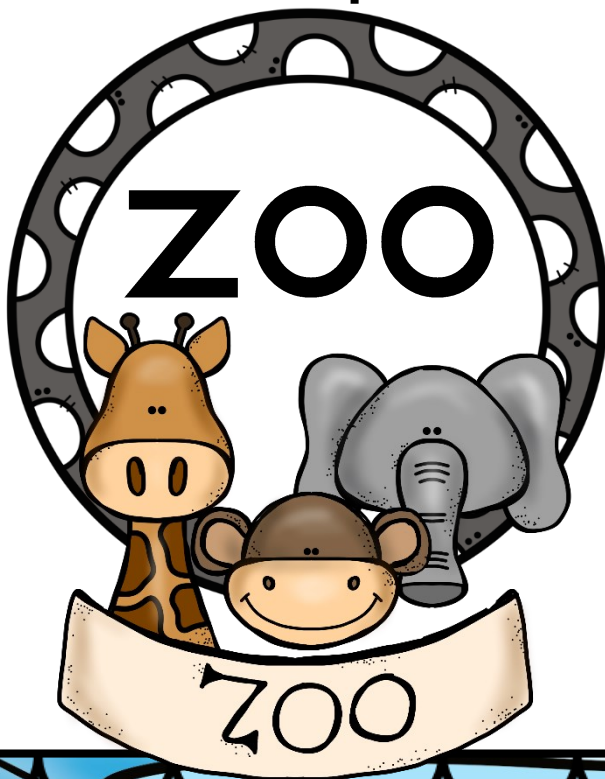
Name of a **person**, **place** or **thing**.

Example:

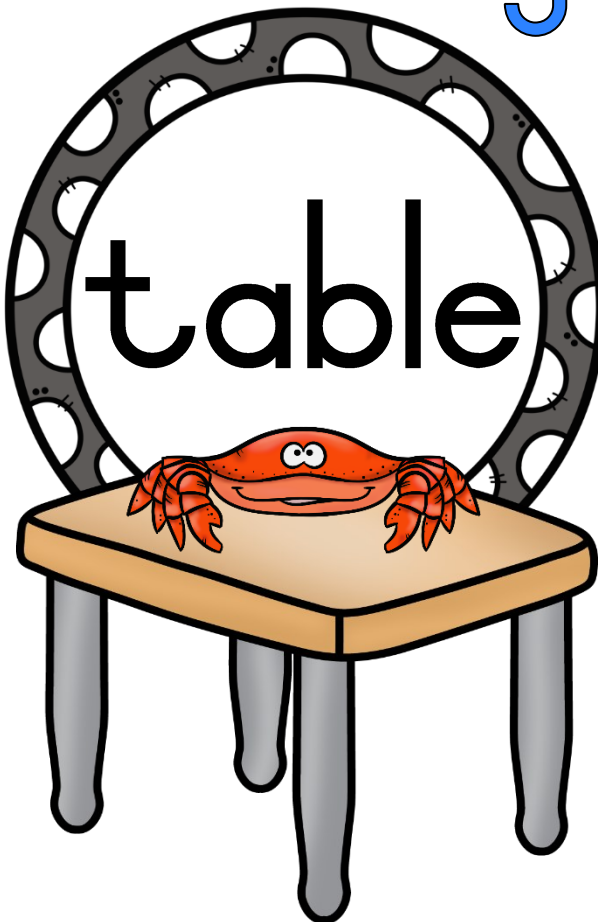
girl



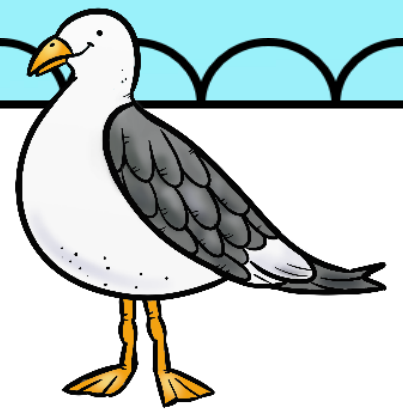
zoo

# Adverb

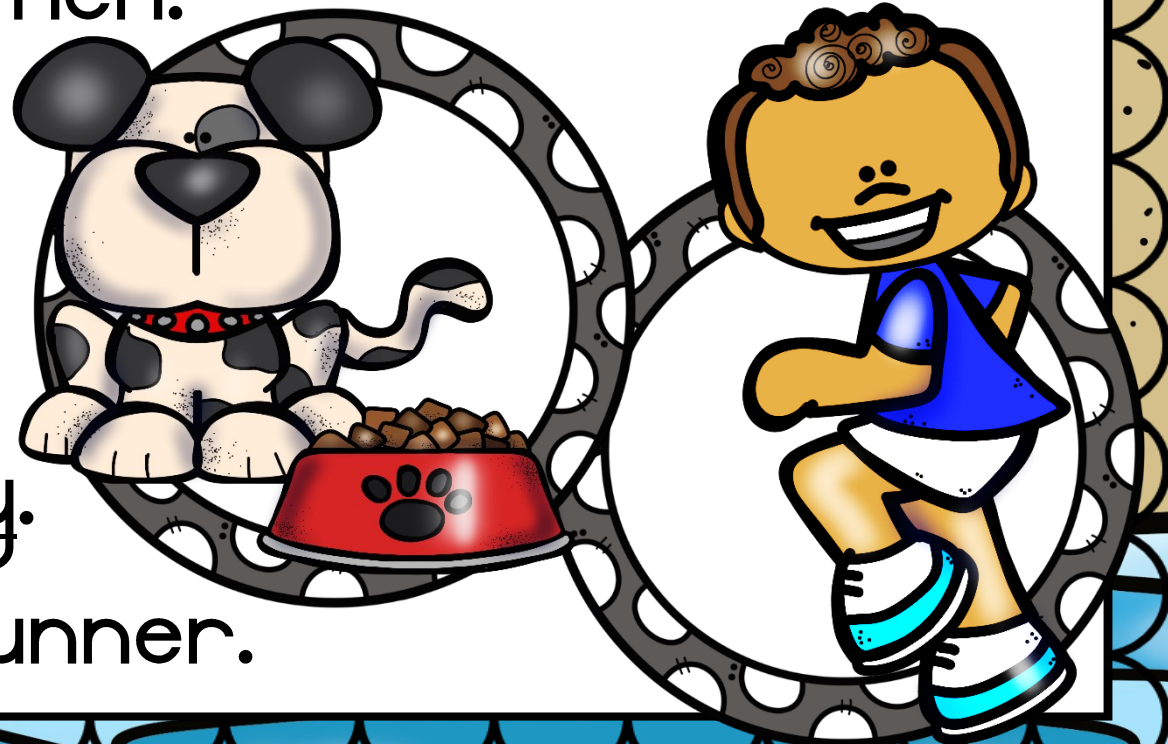


An adverb describes a **verb**, **adjective** or another **adverb**. It tells us how, how often, where or when.

Example:

The dog ate quickly.

Charlie is a fast runner.



# Adjective

(describing word)

An adjective gives more information about a **noun** or **pronoun**.

Example:

soft

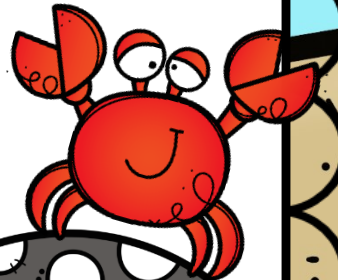
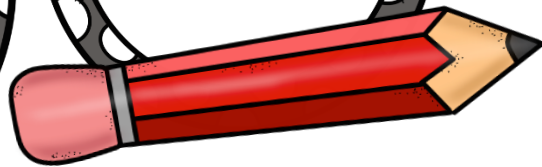
red

He has a red pencil.

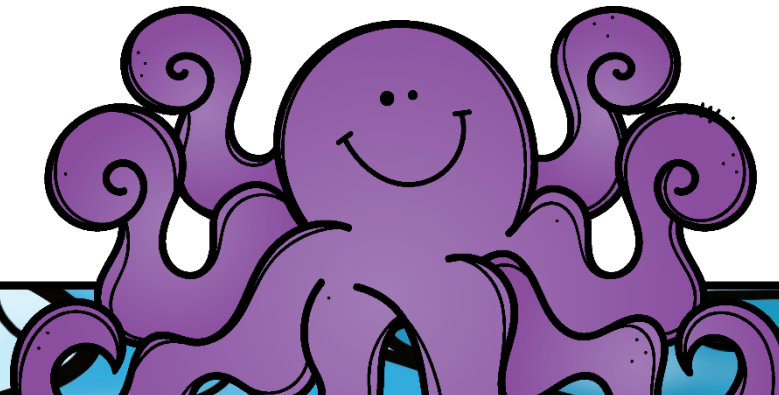


# Verb (action word)

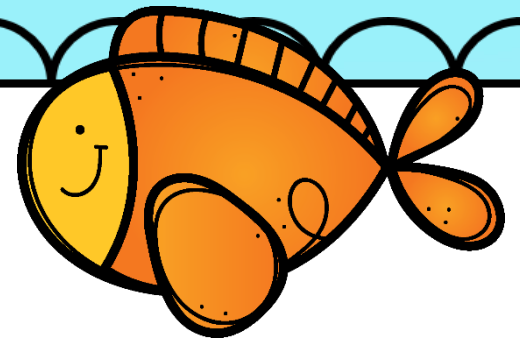
A verb is a word which describes the **action** in a sentence. It is a doing word.
