




Noun




(naming word)

Name of a person, place or thing.

Example:



Adverb




An adverb describes a **verb**, **adjective** or another **adverb**. It tells us how, how often, where or when.

Example:

The dog ate quickly.

Charlie is a fast runner.



Adjective


(describing word)

An adjective gives more information about a noun or pronoun.

Example:

soft

red




Verb


(action word)

A verb is a word which describes the **action** in a sentence. It is a doing word.




Example:
