

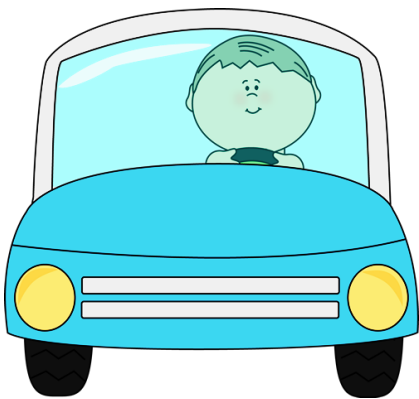
Nouns

A noun names something that you can touch.

- Jan sits on the chair.



- Ben drives the car.



- The cat caught the mouse.



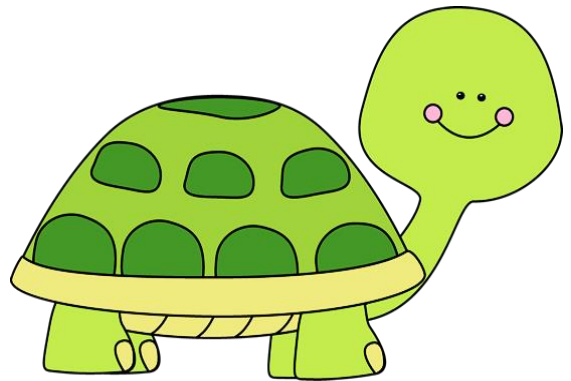
Adjectives

An adjective describes the noun (tells you more about the noun).

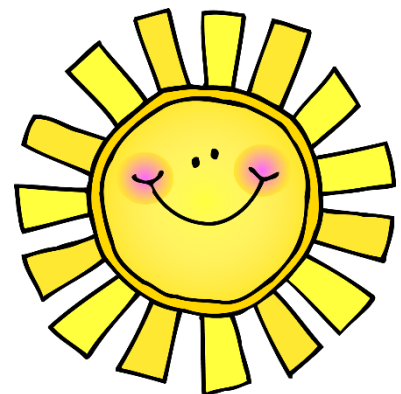
- The **new** car is **green**.



- The **slow** tortoise is **old**.



- The **yellow** sun shines **bright**.



Verbs

A verb is a doing word, it describes the action of the noun.

Karla **swims** in the pool.

The words **is** and **by** can also be used as verbs.

- The boy **is** ill.
 - The dog is loved **by** the boy.

A verb can also be in the past tense.

- She **played** with her dolls yesterday.



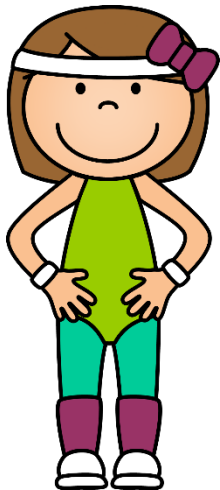
Adverbs

(where)



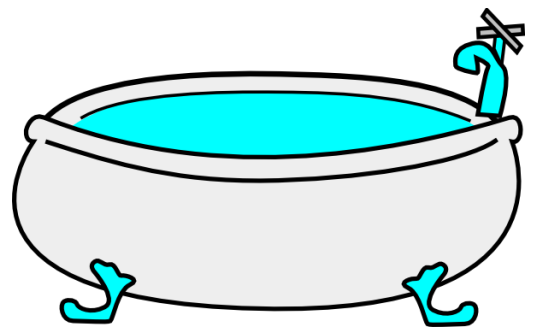
- The children are playing outside.

(how)

Adverb of time
(when)
